

Spirit Committee Meeting

May 25, 2021

This special meeting of the Spirit Committee was called to order at 2:34 p.m. Present were Chairman Carl McEntarffer, Committee members Chris Barber, Lorelee McKee, Will Ritter and Kevin Williams. Discussion- 4th of July Freedom Fest (Action Item):

Ms. Coderniz stated the vendors are starting to come in. Upon inquiry from Ms. Coderniz, Chairman McEntarffer stated there are four 220 outlets in the park and explained where they were located. Mr. M Williams stated they would need to confirm with Mike Hensley from Public Works on the number of outlets. Mr. M Williams inquired about the IdaLicious vendor, and Mr. Barber stated he spoke with them last night regarding the event. Discussion was held on the different vendors to invite to the event and different sponsors to seek. Ms. Elliott stated there is \$100 left over from the previous year. Ms. Coderniz stated the vendor map has been corrected. Mr. M Williams stated he will start posting weekly updated flyers on Facebook with the new sponsors. Ms. McKee stated Deya has been reaching out to the previous vendors. More discussion was held on other various vendors to invite, when to limit vendors needing power, electrical inspections, and limiting same types of vendors. Mr. M Williams stated Neal Christensen reached out to him regarding the fireworks. Mr. Christensen provides the fireworks display for CSI and would like to put a bid in next year. Mr. Harrison stated the Fire Department has all of the fencing for the fireworks and possibly enough for the beer garden. They will also provide the flag at the park, and they will have personnel at the High School. Upon inquiry from Chairman McEntarffer, Ms. Elliott and Ms. Coderniz affirmed the Public Works department is working on the road closure from ITD.
